# Gift Aid Scheme



## You earn taxable income:


- Income Tax as employee or self employed
- Tax on savings account, private pension, investment income
- Capital Gains Tax, e.g. sale of property or shares



You pay tax on this income:

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- This is normally deducted automatically
- Also see amount specified in Self-Assessment form for those that have filled
- Note Tax year runs from April 6 2016 to April 5 2017



### Government spend on:

- Health & Education
- Social Services
- Public Order

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 Gift Aid Scheme Government incentive as charities aid
communities [Higher rate tax payers can also benefit personally]







#### Charity gets Gift Aid:

- Charity gets 25% Gift Aid supplement where donor has provided consent & paid enough Income or Capital Gains Tax
- Separate Gift Aid consent is required for each charity, e.g. AMA UK, Ansarullah UK, MKA UK, Lajna UK, HF, Save the Children, etc

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Who should provide consent? Every man and woman who pays sufficient Income or Capital Gains tax.

How much Tax must I have paid? You must have paid 25% of your total contribution to charities that you have provided Gift Aid consent for over the financial year.
